Speed Check sets are collections of short tossup-style questions that, like our lightning rounds, were written primarily for use on televised quiz shows around the country, but now they're available as practice material.

Shorter questions are useful for warming up at the start of practice or for doing more rapid-fire drilling with your team. These questions are short but still packed with clues in a pyramidal structure (hardest clues first, easiest clues last).

Check your speed with these Speed Checks:

 answer: (alpha-)amino acids (prompt on "peptide")
